Jones & Jones is currently doing site planning and design of a replacement for the “Chadar”—an outdated dining facility that has been the heart and soul of the Camp Schechter experience for generations of camp alumni.

Camp Solomon Schechter is the premier camp for conservative Judaism in the Pacific Northwest. Our design is reminiscent of the existing Chadar. Distinctive elements such as wood finishes, natural light, views, layers of camper artwork, sacred spaces, and the blending of indoor and outdoor space will be preserved in a new, larger facility that meets future program needs for food service, dining, a central gathering place, and flexible spaces for meetings and events.

- Small dispensary with exam space for distributing medication
- Service Yard screened from camp life
- Indoor and outdoor restrooms
