**This is the first of four student cultural centers designed by Jones & Jones on the University campus to be constructed. It provides a gathering place for Native American students, faculty and Native OSU alumni.**

The design for both site and building—developed in collaboration with OSU Native students—reflects the traditional Oregon Coast longhouse character while respecting all tribal cultures of Oregon State. The site includes an honoring place for former OSU Native students and faculty at the location of the original OSU Native American Long House. Art by Oregon Native artists is used throughout the site and building, including a donated totem.

The center honors the culture of the Native American community and fosters "cross-cultural" campus life.
