Springing from the longhouse style traditions of the indigenous peoples of the Pacific Northwest, this cultural center will provide a learning and gathering space for Native American students, faculty, and staff on the campus of the University of Washington.

The Intellectual House will be a place that encourages tribes in Washington State and the Pacific Northwest to visit and actively participate in expanding Native American educational opportunities and achievements on campus. It will also be a welcoming educational environment for diverse communities to come together to share their knowledge and their cultures with one another.

The facility will promote the value of diversity and respect for indigenous cultures.
