The plan combines traditional forms of regulation and acquisition with innovative techniques for education and incentives to protect open space and resources.

To augment our resource inventory process, we enlisted county residents to help identify signature landscapes and other critical resources, along with the conditions which they believed threatened these resources.

This process, along with numerous community meetings, engendered an ownership of the plan and its final recommendations. Elements of this plan have since been incorporated into the County’s Growth Management efforts.
