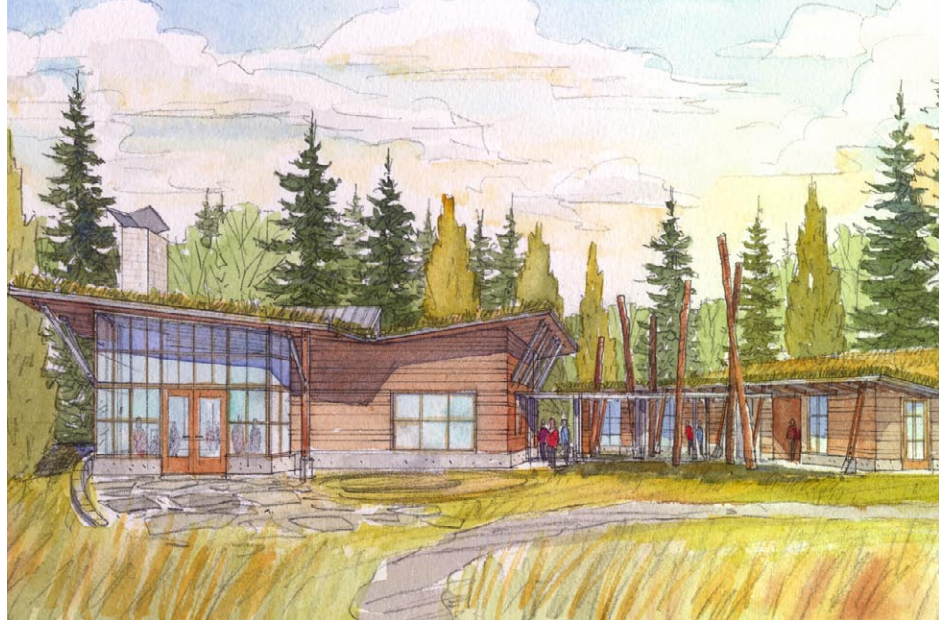

The Jack Hunter O'Dell Education and Reflection Center is a catalyst for community connection—a place for life-long learning, solving community problems, nonviolence training, stewardship, and positive change in public education.

The concept plan by Jones & Jones provides a vision for how the center can grow to adequately accommodate its existing activities. A new learning center and separate studios will employ energy-efficient mechanical systems, living roofs, durable materials, and construction practices to minimize resource depletion and habitat destruction. The expanded center has been designed as an integral part of the landscape and will create a sense of ecological connection for visitors. Restoration of native plant communities along nearby Soos Creek is underway.
