Jones & Jones is preparing a vision and site master plan for the Cabot's Pueblo Museum Complex at the edge of the Mojave and Colorado Deserts.

Cabot Terxa discovered the hot, healing mineral waters that gave rise to the Desert Hot Springs spa culture and spent more than 30 year in the desert building the Pueblo.

The Pueblo will be preserved as the centerpiece of a new cultural complex that reconnects Desert Hot Springs to the natural landscape of the Coachella Valley, and provide trailheads to Joshua Tree National Park and the proposed Sands to Snow National Monument.
