



## SITKA SEAWALK

**As part of the larger Downtown Districts Master Plan team, Jones & Jones developed a waterfront seawalk plan linking several downtown districts from McConnell Bridge to the National Historic Park.**

The seawalk was one of the priority projects in the overall master plan, including shoreline and upland portions of the walk, interpretive signage, wayfinding and orientation signage, landscape and streetscape amenities, and walkability improvements.

Once completed, the seawalk will provide an integrated and continuous multi-use shoreline pathway, and an easily walkable and enjoyable connection to downtown and other visitor destinations.

Provides a safe pedestrian connection from downtown to the museum, fish hatchery, science center, and the Sitka Historical Park  
Preserves local beach access for fishing

Maintains the scenic seaside geology and sensitive Sitka spruce forest
