



KAZIRANGA FOREST TRAIL

Beginning at a waterfall, this meandering trail takes visitors on a journey through the marshlands and dense bamboo forests of India—home of a family of five Asian elephants.

The exhibit and its associated breeding program are linked to conservation efforts in India's Kaziranga National Park, a World Heritage Site. The trail follows streams to several pools and elephant feeding areas. The elephants can find seclusion, but also appear above visitors on overlooks, including one at the waterfall's edge. The Elephant House is a state-of-the-art breeding facility, with separate cow and bull barns and exhibit areas.

Birthplace of the first two Asian Elephants born in Ireland
