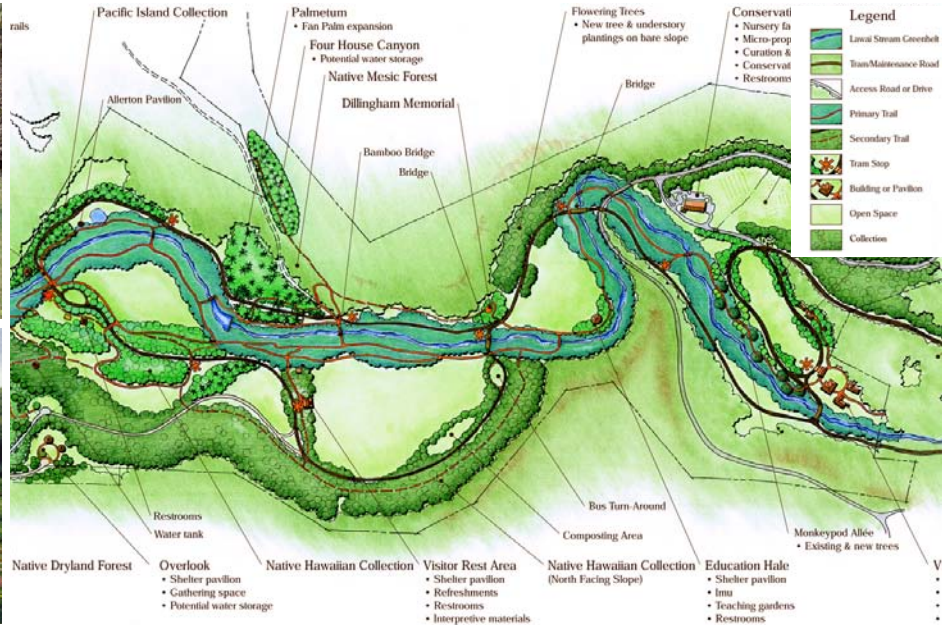

The Jones & Jones master plan identifies key gardens of historical significance, delineates new gardens, educational displays and thematic presentations, and reinforces Hawaiian identity and heritage. It will improve vehicular and pedestrian circulation, develop visitor services and operational facilities, and renovate existing utility services in the garden.
